- We do not plan to double cast at this time. If you cannot be at a show we will not be able to cast you, but we'd love to have you audition for another show!
- The production team will work VERY hard to keep to this schedule but there may be days that we finish early, work ahead, work more slowly, or need to stay a few minutes over time. This is rare and we will allow you to notify your rides.
- On occasion we will also hold rehearsals during SRC to solidify learning; after all, we want this production to be AMAZING!

I understand that, to participate in the musical I must pay the \$75 fee (\$25 for costumes/cleaning, \$30 participation, \$20 music/rights). I also understand that I must NOT have any U'S on my citizenship and that by committing to participate in this show I will be expected to attend ALL rehearsals (unless previously written on the conflict calendar) AND all performances. Dropping below a 90% attendance rate may lead to being replaced. (Please list all conflicts between Oct. 17 – Jan. 30 on the provided calendar.)
