Strategic Direction #1: Improving teaching and personalized learning for the development of each learner.

How will we measure?	Raise the number of students meeting state standards in Reading and Math by 2-6 percentage points.
What are we doing?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Making sure our teaching is aligned to the state expectations. • Checking in with students and progress monitoring frequently to make sure they are continuing to grow in their learning. • Using data to serve students needs - ensuring they get scaffolding and/or extensions
What will you notice?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More lessons on work on important academic vocabulary. • Increased student voice and informal check points of student learning • Fewer “closed” activities where possible student answers are narrow and more “open” activities implemented where students have to find complex answers.

Strategic Direction #2: Fostering a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment

How will we measure?	Increase the number of students saying they have a trusted adult at school and feel safe at school.
What are we doing?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counselors meeting with every single student 2x per year • Intentional lessons about social and emotional learning during morning meeting • Clarified PBIS expectations for behavior and school climate
What will you notice?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A greater focus during class time and expected behaviors during transitional times • Regular updates about social emotional lessons with suggestions about how to support social emotional growth at home. • Emotional growth from your learner
