MISSION

DeMatha Catholic High School is a college preparatory institution dedicated to educating young men in the Trinitarian tradition. Its historic and ongoing mission is to serve students of differing abilities, interests, and backgrounds from the culturally rich and diverse greater Washington DC Metropolitan area.

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Founded by the Order of the Most Holy Trinity in 1946, DeMatha first opened its doors with an enrollment of only 18 students. As it was established, the primary focus of the school was to educate and prepare those interested in becoming clergy in the Trinitarian Order.

Soon after, Catholic parents requested that their sons be granted permission to enroll at DeMatha due to lack of Catholic high schools and facilities in the metropolitan area. Following their tradition of service to the community, the Trinitarians agreed and began accepting a limited number of lay students.

A school building was constructed in 1950, with additions completed in 1959 and 1991. The six-acre wireless campus now also includes a Convocation Center, Music Center, and Arts Center. In October 2021, the school broke ground for the Cross Center for Engineering, Arts, and Robotics.

As DeMatha Catholic High School continues now in its seventh decade of existence, its importance in the community is as crucial as ever. Its current enrollment of over 800 students comes from over 120 feeder schools. It strives to provide an oasis of spiritual, academic, artistic, and athletic instruction, leading young men on the path of hard work and good citizenry with balance and perspective as constant guides.

TRINITARIAN TRADITION

The Brothers of the Holy Trinity were founded in 1198 by St. John de Matha and renewed by St. John Baptist of the Conception in 1599.

The Trinitarian Order strives to model the love and unity of the Trinity. Upholding the freedom of all people, especially the broken who are marked by the hardships of the human condition, they are committed to a way of life rooted in the Gospel and expressed in works of mercy and redemption. In 1931, the Trinitarians established a monastery in Hyattsville, Maryland because of the proximity to Catholic University.

There are currently 5 religious on the faculty and staff at DeMatha Catholic High School. The Trinitarian influence and heritage of the school guides a comprehensive program that strives to form students morally and spiritually.

Today, the Order of the Most Holy Trinity and of the Captives is active on five continents.

- Oversee management of the financial, accounting, business technology, purchasing and contract management, in addition to facilities and human resources activities of the organization. This includes cash management, investment policy, systems integrity, risk management, and compliance.
- Provide leadership and guidance to the finance department / business office by presenting highly insightful and usable information and advice to facilitate management's decision-making.
- Supervise and analyze the effectiveness of accounting, procurement, and business technology systems while establishing processes and internal controls to maximize and protect the organization's resources.
- Develop policies, guidelines, and procedures for effective financial and risk management while continuously looking for opportunities and identifying areas to improve operations and implement best practices.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITES

- Direct the planning, development, implementation, budgeting, maintenance, and support of all department functions.
- Administer, manage, and develop policies, standards, practices, and security measures to assure effective and consistent operations and ensure the protection of assets.

- Review overall capital and debt needs of the organization and develop ideas and strategies for capital raising and debt issuance.
