Congratulations Sobrato Students and Staff!

Sobrato is #151 in California of 2,613 public high schools = 5.7% or Top 6%

*Note: 1,536 schools qualified for ranking

Sobrato is #994 in the United States of 24,980 public high schools = 3.9% or Top 4%

*Note: 17,680 schools qualified for ranking

Schools were required to have assessment data available to be reviewed for a ranking.

Summary:

Nonprofit research firm RTI International assessed schools on 6 factors:

- College readiness, based on the proportion of 12th grade students who took and earned a qualifying score on at least one Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam (30% of ranking).
- State assessment proficiency, based on aggregated scores on state assessments that students may be required to pass for graduation (20%).
- State assessment performance, based on whether performance on state assessments exceeded expectations given the school's proportion of underserved students (20%).
- Underserved student performance, based on how Black, Hispanic and low-income students performed on state assessments compared with those who are not underserved in the state (10%).
- College curriculum breadth, based on proportions of 12th grade students who took and earned a qualifying score on AP and/or IB exams in multiple content areas (10%).

• Graduation rate, based on the proportion of students who entered ninth grade and graduated four years later (10%).

All of the data is collected from third-party sources. U.S. News receives AP and IB data directly from the College Board and International Baccalaureate, respectively. The state assessment data and graduation rates are from each state, and other data comes from the U.S. Department of Education Common Core of Data.

<u>Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) / National Merit Scholarshop Quaifiying Test (NMSQT) Information</u>



Get PSAT/NMSQT Ready!

 On Wednesday, October 11, 2023 Sobrato High School students will be taking the PSAT/NMSQT test on site at Sobrato High School during the regular school day.

- 10th graders: Sobrato High School students in the 10th Grade will be taking the exam free
 of charge. 10th grade students do not need to register for the exam, and a test will
 automatically be ordered for this grade level.
- If an 11th grader wants to be recognized by the National Merit Scholarship Program, they must take this exam during their 11th grade year to qualify. If they qualify for this recognition, it can lead to scholarships, and it can be helpful in their college application process.
- 9th and 11th graders: 9th and 11th grade students can reserve a seat for the PSAT/NMSQT exam for a nominal fee of \$27 by clicking on the <u>link</u> and purchasing a seat at the ASB store. For 9th and 11th graders, tests must be purchased by **September 29th** on the ASB website, in order to reserve your space.
- In order to take the exam, you also must create your free <u>College Board account</u>. When
 you create your account, please store your password in a safe place! We cannot help you
 recover your password. If you lose it, you will have to call College Board directly to reset
 your password.
- Check out the <u>College Board</u> and <u>Naviance</u> websites for FREE test prep resources.
- Calculators can be used on the PSAT but it is not required. Click the <u>link</u> if you want to review approved calculators by CollegeBoard. If you have a calculator, please bring it on the day of the exam. We also will have some calculators available to loan during the test.

General Information

Activity Bus - began Tuesday September 5th!



Students who are staying late at school for Homework Center, Math Help Center or other school activities have the opportunity to take the **Activity Bus** home from school. See the details below for more information:

Days: Monday – Thursday

Departure: 4:35pm

- No extra charge to students who already have a valid 2023-2024 MHUSD bus pass round-trip or PM transportation
- \$10 for students without a bus pass (good for the remainder of the year). It is free for students with a roundtrip,
- Activity buses will start running on Sept 5, 2023, and end on May 23, 2024.

Attendance Policy

Daily attendance is important to success in school. **Students are expected to have an attendance rate of 90% or higher to remain in good standing**. All absences, excused or not, contribute to a student's attendance rate.

Remember in any one class:

- At 6 unexcused absences, the student loses <u>all extracurricular privileges</u> for the current semester.
- At 8 unexcused absences, the student may lose credit for the class
- 3 unexcused tardies are equivalent to 1 unexcused absence
- If a student's attendance rate is less than 90%, they will not be eligible for any extracurricular activities.

Guardians are responsible for monitoring their student's attendance. Guardians can log on to their Aeries portal or call the office between 8:00am and 4:00pm to monitor their student's attendance. Please call (408) 201-6221 within 3 days of the absence. If families call after the 3 days, we are unable to change the unexcused absence. Guardians are also encouraged to email individual teachers regarding potential attendance errors or other issues of concern. Teachers should respond within 2 business days.

Physician Medicine Authorization 2023-2024

If you anticipate your child will need to take medication, use an inhaler or epipen during the 2023-2024 school year, CEC Section 49423 requires that a new physician authorization form for medication administration be filled out every school year. You may use the form below or one generated by your physician. All medication permission forms must be signed and dated by both the doctor and a parent/guardian.
