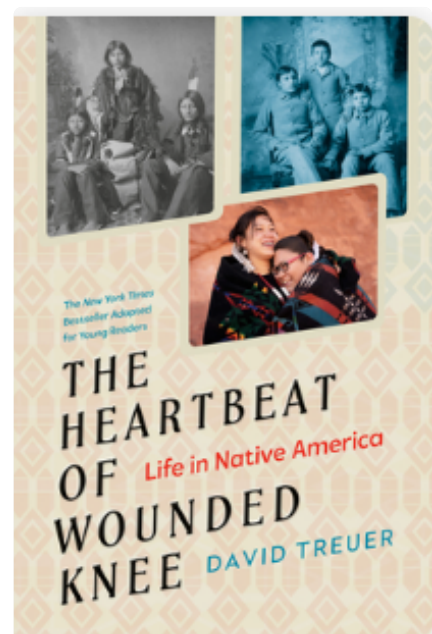
#### **Foul Lady Fortune by Chloe Gong**

## Collaboration Corner

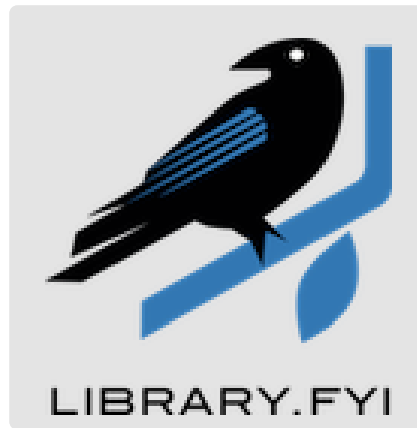

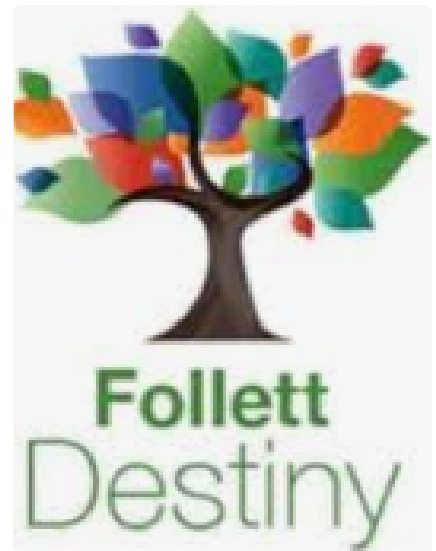
