

<b>7450</b>	<b>Fund-Raising</b>

The Ballston Spa Board of Education recognizes the benefit of voluntary contributions of money, goods, and services by various stakeholders in the community. However, fundraising should be restricted to activities that directly:

- a. Enhance the curriculum;
- b. Support charitable activities/events;
- c. Supplement pre-approved competitive or ceremonial events;
- d. Cover operating expenses.

The superintendent is charged with developing procedures to monitor and limit the impact of fundraising activities on our students and community based on these guidelines:

- a. Fundraising activities that involve community outreach in the name of the Ballston Spa Central School District must be pre-approved annually by the principal and superintendent of schools.
- b. Participation in fundraising activities must be voluntary for students and parents.
- c. Incentive-based, competitive sales programs rewarding individuals are prohibited.
- d. Door-to-door sales are prohibited.
- e. Fundraising proceeds may be used to supplement but not supplant purchases or activities normally provided for in the District's budget.
- f. Proposed fundraisers that involve food or beverages should adhere to the district Wellness Policy's nutritional guidelines.
