The successful bidder, will be required to furnish a Labor and Material Bond in the amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the contract price and a Faithful Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, said bonds are to be secured from a surety company satisfactory to the Oroville High School District.

Bidders are hereby notified that pursuant to the provisions of Section 1720-1861 et. seq. of the State of California Labor Code, the Director of the State Department of Industrial Relations has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the rates for overtime and holiday work in the bcality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of workman needed, applicable as of the date of the Bid Advertisement, copies of which may be obtained online through the Department of Labor and Statistics at http://www.dir.ca.gov/dlsr/pwd or at the District Office by any interested party, and in the case of a contract, a copy shall be posted at the job site.
