

Our 2019 Alum of the Year was nominated by a PHS football teammate! He described this year's nominee as kind and hardworking. A man who came from nothing, served his country, learned a valuable skill and turned that skill into his own business. Living the American Dream even further when the business became a family business of three generations!

Charles Kerns was born in Holton, KS in December of 1936. His family moved to Plattsmouth when he was a young child.

He attended Plattsmouth Schools from Kindergarten until he graduated in 1954 when he graduated. While in High School, Charlie played football for the Blue Devils and was also a tuba player for the Plattsmouth High School Marching Band.

He met Ella Mary Nielsen his freshman year in high school and during their sophomore year they began dating and dated all the rest of their high school years. Following high school he joined the Navy and even though he wasn't stationed in Korea he did serve during the Korean Conflict. During his ser-

He helped buy and install the handrails in the current Blue Devil stadium so he could go to the games and sit up high enough in the bleachers that he could watch his grandsons play for the Blue Devils. They have done pipe and utility work at all the other buildings in the District as well.




