Weston Ranch High School is one of five comprehensive public high schools in the Manteca Unified School District.

WRHS is located 50 miles south of our state capital Sacramento in the San Joaquin Valley.

Accreditation: Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC)

Enrollment: 1206

Curriculum: Weston Ranch High School is on a 4 x 4 block schedule. Students are enrolled in four 90-minute classes - 5 days a week. Students can earn 80 credits per school year.

Graduation Requirements: 275 credits are required. to meet graduation requirements at Weston Ranch High School. Credits are adjusted for students who transfer to Weston Ranch High School from a traditional high school.
