**Weston Ranch High School** is one of five comprehensive public high schools in the Manteca Unified School District. WRHS is located 50 miles south of our state capital Sacramento in the San Joaquin Valley.

**Accreditation:** Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC)  
**Enrollment:** 1206

**Curriculum:** Weston Ranch High School is on a 4 x 4 block schedule. Students are enrolled in four 90-minute classes - 5 days a week. Students can earn 80 credits per school year.

**Graduation Requirements:** 275 credits are required. to meet graduation requirements at Weston Ranch High School. Credits are adjusted for students who transfer to Weston Ranch High School from a traditional high school.

**Method of GPA and Ranking:** Students are ranked by academic achievement within their grade level. The G.P.A. is weighted on a 4.0 scale and includes all courses with a letter grade A-F. Honors and Advanced Placement classes receive 1 extra grade point for classes with a C grade or higher.
