AAFAA - Advanced Academics and Fine Arts Academy

Starting in the 2020-2021 school year, Forney ISD opened the Advanced Academics Fine Arts Academy (AAFAA) at Blackburn Elementary. Students in this program have received specialized instruction in fine arts courses, including piano, dance, and theatre. Additionally, students have received core academic instruction in an accelerated/compacted environment that is tailored to the young GT/Advanced brain.

ACP - Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a U.S. government program run by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to help low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices like a laptop or tablet.

CKH - Capturing Kids Hearts

Capturing Kids Hearts is a unique training program implemented by the district in which teachers, staff, and administrators learn and practice skills they will use and model in their classrooms, schools, and districts, including how to build meaningful, productive relationships with every student and every colleague.

COE - Culture of Excellence

CTE - Career & Technology Education

Forney ISD's Career & Technology Education program exists to serve all students by helping them discover their own unique strengths and interests. The program prepares all students to continue to learn in institutions of higher learning, and provide quality training and opportunities for entry-level (or above) employment.

DEIC - District Educational Improvement Council

In compliance with Education Code 11.251, the District Educational Improvement Council (committee) shall advise the Board or its designee in establishing and reviewing the District's educational goals, objectives, and major District-wide classroom instructional programs identified by the Board or its designee. The committee shall serve exclusively in an advisory role except that the committee shall approve staff development of a District-wide nature. The committee is composed of members who represent campus-based professional staff, District-level professional staff, parents, business and the community. At least two-thirds of the District and campus professional staff shall be classroom teachers. The remaining one-third shall be professional non-teaching staff.

DOI - District of Innovation

Forney ISD is among a list of school district in Texas that are Districts of Innovation. A District of Innovation is a concept passed by the 84th Legislative Session in House Bill 1842, effective immediately, that gives traditional independent school districts most of the flexibilities available to Texas' open enrollment charter schools. To access these flexibilities, a school district must adopt an innovation plan, as set forth in the Texas Education Code chapter 12A. (TASB)

ECSE - Early Childhood Special Education

ECSE is a special education program for students ages 3 and 4 that focuses on providing early intervention for delays in developmental skills: speech/communication, social/emotional, physical, cognitive and adaptive behavior. There are a spectrum of services available including speech therapy and classroom programs. Students qualify for ECSE after completing a special education evaluation done by the district.

EOC - End-of-Course

End-of-Course assessments measure students' academic performance in core high school courses. Educators, administrators and parents.

FACT - Forney Academy to Certify Teachers

The F.A.C.T. Program is an innovative pathway for students of Forney ISD to graduate, gain employment, complete their degree and solidify their career path as a certified teacher without ever leaving our district.

FEF - Forney Education Foundation

The Forney ISD Education Leadership Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit tax exempt organization created in 2003 and formalized in 2004. The purpose of the foundation is to light the way for teaching and learning in Forney ISD through the Advantage Plus+ program and innovative teaching grants.

FERPA - Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records and gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records.

MAP - Measure of Academic Progress

MAP Growth uses a RIT scale to accurately measure what students know, regardless of their grade level.

MTSS - Multi-Tiered Systems of Support

MTSS is a data-driven, problem-solving framework to improve outcomes for all students. It relies on a continuum of evidence-based practices matched to student needs. Forney ISD is committed to providing all students equitable learning experiences to exhibit master and growth with appropriate support. Interventions and enrichments are research-based, individualized, implemented with fidelity and targeted to meet the needs of the whole child. It is a systematic process that is simple, clear, and district-aligned which includes ongoing professional development. MTSS is in addition to effective classroom instruction and management that is data driven, monitored, adjusted, and documented.

Skyward (parent portal, student information, SIS)

Skyward is a Student Information System (SIS) for students, parents, teachers and administrators. It is an automated school management and student information system that fulfills human resources, student database, staff management, finance, and accounting needs of educational institutions and school districts.

Parents and students have access to the portal to view tasks and grades, check preferences, email teachers, see the lunch calendar, etc.

SMART Tag - Secured Mobility Authorized Ridership Technology

Forney ISD uses the Secured Mobility Authorized Ridership Technology (SMART) tag system for all students who ride the bus to and from school. Each of our buses is outfitted with a Samsung tablet equipped with a Radio Frequency Identification reader, mobile connectivity, and Global Positioning System. Similar to systems used in public transportation, students place their campus-supplied SMART tag ID badges on the tablet's sensor when loading and unloading their bus. Only the student's name and associated barcode will be printed on the ID badge. No information is stored on the badge.

STAAR - State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness

STAAR is the state's testing program and is based on state curriculum standards in core subjects including reading, writing, mathematics, science, and social studies.

STEAM Camps

Summer camps that focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics principals. Open to all students that have completed kindergarten and above. Registration opens in the spring semester.

Synergy

Synergy is an educational program for high school students in Forney ISD that provides students the opportunity to learn and work in a real-world work environment! Students in Synergy enroll in practicum classes for two or three periods a day. During this time, they travel to the district's central administration building and work side-by-side with district leaders.

TEA - Texas Education Agency

The Texas Education Agency is the state agency that oversees primary and secondary public education.

TIA - Teacher Incentive Allotment

The Teacher Incentive Allotment (TIA) was created by the Texas Legislature as part of House Bill 3 to provide a realistic pathway for top teachers to earn six-figure salaries and to help attract and retain highly effective teachers at traditionally hard-to-staff schools.
