ENROLLMENT

There are 1,175 students in grades nine through 12 from Marion County and its 10 surrounding counties. Students attended approximately 164 different schools before entering Cathedral. Of the 1,175 students, 36 percent are students of color and 73 percent are Catholic.

98 faculty members with 56 percent having advanced degrees. The average student-teacher ratio is 11:1.
