Greenheck Field House/Greenheck Turner Community Center





The Greenheck Turner Community Center is a 135,000 square foot indoor turf facility, as an addition to the current Greenheck Fieldhouse, that will accommodate a full size field of 120 yards x 70 yards, walking track, jump pit, batting cages, and ample viewing spaces. This facility will enhance health, wellness, athletics and quality of life for the community for years to come. The additional space will strengthen the current indoor gym space, racketball courts, fitness center, group fitness center studio and ice area for the Central Wisconsin area.

As a community center, it will include space for youth and high school activities such as soccer, football, lacrosse, softball, baseball, golf, track & field, band and dance. It also will have the ability to host tournaments, camps, community events and individual user groups. This year-round facility will be open for all and includes a walking track, meeting rooms, simulators and bleacher seating.

The new entrance will be on ground level making it easier for ice participants as well as visitors to the facility. The current fitness center, ice arena and field house will remain a part of the overall center and continue to enhance the user experience. We anticipate opening in fall of 2024 and will accommodate organizations from all over the region.

The Greenheck Turner Community
Center is named after Mary Greenheck
Turner who passed away in 2019. Her
father Robert C. Greenheck and her
husband Scott L. Turner along with
Mary's three brothers Jim, Paul and
Bobby have been supporters of the
project from the very beginning. The
Greenheck family supported the
original Greenheck Field House which
was built in 1997.

The D.C. Everest Area Education Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is leading the fundraising effort. All funds will be privately contributed - no public money from the district or taxes will be used to fundraise for the facility. Once in operation, the facility will run at cost via facility use fees for user groups. Any individual or entity may rent the space for their desired use just as Greenheck Field House currently operates.

GTCC will fill a regional need for year-round practice space. Each field is the equivalent of three field house gyms. Because there are no other comparable facilities nearby, it is projected many regional teams, competitors and events will be hosted in addition to local organizations.

Weekend tournaments, games, events and festivals will attract people regionally and statewide. It is projected the months of October-April will see the largest volume of visits from youth sports groups and adult and youth leagues, who will host clinics, games, leagues and tournaments.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

As the construction project progresses, each day brings new excitement. Very soon, the tennis courts will be complete to the south of the Simon baseball field. The tennis courts needed to be relocated, updated and resurfaced due age and as part of the overall blueprint, and will offer multiple tiered seating. This will allow tennis to host larger tournaments and sectionals. The courts are made with the newest technology, allowing the concrete to expand and contract with the changing weather. This technology is the first in the state. These courts will also be available for pickleball with portable nets as well. The tennis courts are utilizing a system known as "post tension concrete" for the base material. The post tension system uses cables pulled under pressure after the concrete is poured to give a stable surface with minimal cracking. This system should reduce the maintenance to the courts and prolong the life expectancy.









GTCC will offer meeting room space for organizations, businesses, and nonprofits to rent. Each space will have ample natural lighting, technology access and moveable seating to accomodate the user. The widescreen simulators will also be a great addition to any corporate training or employee wellness day.
