

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Contacts with Students

The schools may communicate information through students regarding the schools and school programs and non-school programs offered by organizations that, in the opinion of the superintendent, or designee, have social, recreational or educational value to the students. The effect on students of such communication and participation will be given paramount consideration. Appropriate safeguards will be established to prevent the exploitation of students.

Any organization that seeks to distribute information about its program shall submit a letter to the superintendent, or designee, showing:

- 1) A plan which describes the extent and nature of the proposed school involvement and outlined in detail, or
- 2) That the activity or promotion is directly related to the educational program of the school and worthy of its support.
