STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Attend school on-campus
- Maintain passing grades
- Commit to maintaining an attendance rate of 90% or higher
- Work with mentors
- Attend mandatory tutorials for TSI and EOC assessments

PROGRAM FEATURES

- Dual Credit courses through Lonestar College System
- Small class sizes and lower student to teacher ratios on campus
- Community mentorships
- Ability to achieve an associate's degree or certification while achieving high school credit

VISTAS EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL TEAM

- Classroom Teacher teaches high school credit classes at Vistas campus
- **Dual Credit Teacher** teaches high school and/or college level courses at Vistas campus
- College Professor teaches college level courses either on Vistas campus, online or at Lonestar
- Mentor provides students with direction, support and encouragement
- College Advisor assists students in navigating the college application process, understanding the financial aid process, and transitioning from high school to college, certification program, technical school or the military.

CRITERIA

Students who:

- Are currently enrolled at one of the five KISD high school campuses
- Needing additional support in order to complete high school
- · Would benefit from a small and nurturing learning environment

- · Attend school on-campus
- Commit to maintaining an attendance rate of 90% or above
- Maintain passing grades
- Attend mandatory tutorials for EOC assessments

PROGRAM FEATURES

- · Allows each student to grow socially, emotionally and academically
- Small class sizes and lower student to teacher ratios on campus
- A collaborative community with opportunities to build meaningful relationships with the teachers and staff in order to achieve goals of pursuing a higher education
- Opportunity to earn credits at an accelerated pace due to nine-week terms
- Opportunity to take Dual Credit courses through Lonestar College System and OnRamps Dual Enrollment through the University of Texas

Klein Success Academy Program provides students who need additional support in graduating an opportunity to earn their high school diploma.

CRITERIA

Students who:

- · Are behind in credits (5 or fewer credits remaining)
- Have completed (at a minimum) their third year of high school
- Will be unable to graduate on time otherwise

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Provide their own transportation
- Follow the District Student Code of Conduct as well as rules specific to the program
- Meet course completion goals
- · Attend labs a minimum of 6 hours per week
- Work on their Edgenuity classes Monday through Friday for 2+ hours a day
- Work with mentors and respond to their phone calls
- Attend mandatory EOC tutoring as required

PROGRAM FEATURES

- Online learning
- Self-paced
- EOC tutoring
- Ongoing enrollment
- Flexible schedule

KLEIN SUCCESS ACADEMY TEAM

Teachers have multiple roles, including:

- Lab Facilitator manages the student learning environment
- Content area teacher gives extra support for students who are struggling
- Mentor provides students with direction, support and encouragement
- College Advisor assists students in navigating the college application process, understanding the financial aid process, and transitioning from high school to college, technical school or the military.
