<p>Practise counting to 20, 30 and challenge yourself to count to 100 in 1s: M&N YouTube</p> <p>Encourage your child to count forwards and backwards to at least 30. Count stairs, animals, stones, pebbles. Practise writing numbers using a range of mediums such as pencil, paint, chalk, pens etc. Please ensure numbers are formed correctly. Can they spot any numbers in their environment? Numbers on doors, car registration plates, telephone numbers.</p>	<p>Practise reading and spelling the flower shape tricky words. Use felts, coloured pencils or whiteboard pens to write them. Twist pipe cleaners into the shape of sounds to make words. Use chalk outside to create a tricky word trail and then jump on each one to practise reading them back and spelling out loud.. Go onto Phonics Play and look for the phase your child is on and play some fun games which help your child read words using known sounds. https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</p>	<p>Go on a hunt for a range of different materials in your home and environment. For example: objects which are made from wood, metal, glass, paper, fabric, leaves, flowers etc. Sort them and label them. How many of each material can you find?
