Graduation 2021 is Saturday, May 15!

Mapleton is intending to celebrate the class of 2021 with an in-person graduation ceremony on the field at DiTirro Stadium! This year nearly 400 seniors will receive their Mapleton diploma.

To ensure a special and safe celebration, this event will follow the <u>CDPHE's outdoor event</u> <u>guidance</u>, including mask and social distancing requirements and capacity limits. **Under current guidance, we expect to limit each graduate to 4 same-household guests.** Seating arrangements, parking plans, arrival times, and additional important event information are <u>available online</u>. The ceremony will also be live-streamed in English and Spanish. A link will be available on Mapleton's website prior to the event.

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You might be eligible for Pandemic-EBT benefits this spring. <u>Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT)</u> is a program that provides a one-time payment to provide extra food benefits for qualifying families.

If your family has already qualified for the Free and Reduced Food program during this school

year, then you may also be eligible for P-EBT, and there is nothing further you



need to do. You will automatically receive P-EBT benefits beginning in late May, unless you already have an EBT card (benefits will be loaded in late May to existing EBT cards if you have one).

If you are not already in the Free or Reduced meal program you will need to complete the application this school year. Families who qualify for Free and Reduced School Meals may also receive additional benefits such as discounted school fees, discounted internet, phone services, and additional funds for your school.

Apply for Free and Reduced Meal Program

Applying for free and reduced school meals is fast, easy, and secure. Even if you think you may not qualify, we encourage you to <u>submit the form</u> as soon as possible. This is the only application you need to complete. If you are not on the Free and Reduced meal program, if you qualify then you will also be automatically eligible to qualify for the P-EBT program.

When we started on our capital construction master plan, nearly all of our facilities were more than 50 years old and many had exceeded their useful life. Now, most of our facilities are either new or newly renovated. As we wrap up the many projects made possible by the 2016 bond, we are

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now looking at what we are calling the "final four." These are buildings that have received modest upgrades and improvements over the years, and we are exploring our options when it comes to making these buildings safe and functional for generations to come.
