#### **Academy's STEM Expo**

The Skyview Student Center was transformed into a display of innovation and intelligence for the Academy High School Technology Student Association's (TSA) fifth annual STEM Expo! After months of research, work, planning and preparation, Academy's TSA students shared their projects with high school students as well as elementary students from Clayton Partnership School. This year, students created projects to compete in multiple categories, including physics, robotics, fashion, and architecture. This special event celebrates Academy's STEM focus and allows students an opportunity to explore their interests within science, technology, engineering, and math. Winners of the expo will represent Mapleton Public Schools at the TSA State Conference in February, where they'll compete against students from all corners of the state.

#### **October Count update**

Enrollment in Mapleton schools is up for the eighth consecutive year. October Count data for the 2019-20 school year, released by the Colorado Department of Education, reveals that the number of students choosing to attend Mapleton's brick and mortar schools (excluding Colorado Connections Online Academy) is up to 6,884 - an increase of nearly 100 students. Including Colorado Connections Academy, Mapleton's enrollment is up to 9,161 students. Nearly 65 percent of Mapleton students receive free and reduced lunch, and 1 in 3 students are identified as English Language Learners who are not yet fluent in English (excluding Colorado Connections Academy).

#### **Mapleton receives BEST grant funds for Valley View!**

On Tuesday, Dec. 10, Mapleton's Board of Education unanimously and enthusiastically voted to accept BEST program funding from the Colorado Department of Education to support the rebuild of the Valley View school building.

Mapleton submitted a BEST grant to help support Valley View's rebuild last February. In May, the district was recommended as a back-up candidate for BEST grant funding. In

November, Mapleton received the good news that the state would have the ability to fund the Valley View PK-8 project through the BEST Certificates of Participation Lease-Purchase program.

The BEST grant portion of the project will be \$17,414,793.86. Design meetings for the 'New View' will begin soon

#### **Data-driven instruction in Mapleton**

#### **DDI at Adventure Elementary**

Mapleton schools are using data-driven instruction to improve knowledge, understanding, and skills for all students. Teachers meet regularly and review data to uncover gaps in student understanding and find opportunities for more relevant instruction. At Adventure Elementary, a preschool through sixth grade EL school, teachers meet bi-weekly with the school's Instructional Guide to analyze student results in multiple assessments across all content.

When students need additional support in a specific content area, targeted help is provided to ensure students reach grade-level standards.

When asked what she would like parents to know about data-driven instruction at her school, School Director Amber VonderHofen said, "Data is important and utilized in all grade levels starting in preschool. It is the best way for us to guarantee that our students are making progress toward grade-level standards and are successful in all that they do."

How can parents support data-driven instruction at home? "Read, read, read!" said Ms. VonderHofen. "We encourage parents to talk with their child about what they are learning at school and make sure that they are reading with their child every night. A strong love of reading will translate into motivation for learning!

Every month we will share examples from different schools of how data-driven instruction is improving outcomes for students in Mapleton and how families can use data to support learning at home.



The course is 100 percent online, no textbooks or software needed. It is self-paced, offers easy to follow lessons and is fully interactive with animations, games, and videos. The goal of the course is to increase a new driver's confidence and knowledge in a variety of driving situations. The program is designed to be equivalent to an in-person

classroom experience but can be completed from anywhere with an internet connection. DriveSafe focuses on defensive and safe driving habits to help make new drivers become a safe driver for life. To enroll in the online program,
