

# **Walter Hill Activities and Trip Explanation**

The 2023-2024 WHS calendar has many events planned for students. In regards to activities, there are several events that depend on payment of an activity fee in order to participate.

The activity fee for the 2023-2024 school year is \$95

These events include:

- Two “ Positive Behavior” Assemblies: part of the activity fee pays for these assemblies, including but not limited to materials, prizes, and other necessary items associated with the event
- Kingsway Regional Field Day: During this event, WHS students as well as 6th grade students from East Greenwich & South Harrison School Districts meet at Kingsway Regional High School to participate in games and socialize with their future classmates.
- Walter Hill Celebration Day: A day at the end of the year that is a celebration of the students and their time here at The Hill
- Class Shirts
- Class Picture
- A School Yearbook

Other activities occur throughout the school year, however these are pay-to-play/participate. These activities include

- School Socials
- After School Clubs / Sports
- Trunk or Treat

For our 6th grade trip we are planning a trip to Camp Ockanickon in Medford, NJ. The payment for this trip is separate from the activity fee and will be approximately \$100 (at this time, the cost has not been finalized). The payment will cover the following:

- Guided activities such as archery, canoeing, low ropes course, high ropes courses, team building activities, etc.
- Lunch provided in the camp dining hall
- Transportation to and from the camp for all participants.
