Honors and AP coursework are offered in English, Math, Social Studies and Science. Qualified students may participate in the College Credit Plus (CCP) program at Youngstown State University, and/or Eastern Gateway Community College. Additionally, qualified students may earn university credit through CCP at Poland Seminary High School in English, Calculus, Advanced Pre-Calculus, Physics, Physical Geology, Advanced Biology, Human Anatomy/Physiology, Advanced Chemistry, Intro to Criminal Justice, and Advanced US Government. Special programs exist for learning disabled and at-risk students.
