

STUDENTS ON GOVERNING BOARD

The Longview School District Board of Directors recognizes the value of student representation on the school board so that student voice and input is included in the board's work. The school district will annually seat two student representatives. Student representatives will communicate with other district students and receive their input and perspectives.

Student representatives on the board are expected to attend all board meetings, unless excused by the board.

The student members will contribute to board discussion by providing student insight and perspective, serve as a liaison for the associated student body and report to students about the work of the board and district activities. The board may seek student opinions on agenda items when helpful and appropriate. Student representatives are not voting members of the board and do not factor in the determination of a quorum required for board action.

Student representatives will not attend executive sessions, hold board offices, or participate in quasi-judicial hearings of the board. However, student representatives may periodically be asked by the Board President to attend meetings of board sub-committees or district standing committees when appropriate.
