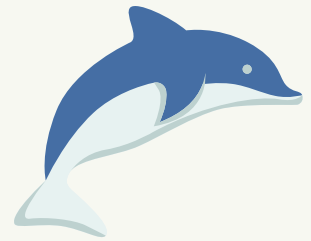


SF Day Summer Camp Newsletter
