

PERSONNELBloodborne Pathogens Occupational Exposure Plan

It is the responsibility of the district to maintain a safe and healthy environment in its schools. Designed to provide effective personnel safeguards against transmission of disease in the school setting, universal precautions shall be observed.

The district's infection control plan shall be consistent with WAC 296-823-11010, Bloodborne Pathogens and the Guidelines for Implementation of Hepatitis B and HIV School Employee Training published by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Those diseases deemed dangerous to public health by the State Board of Health shall be reported to the local health department.
