In the Chotin Center

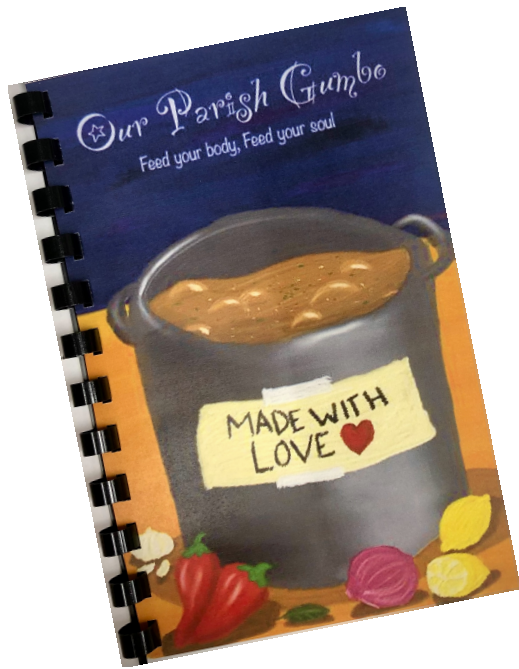
