Year Two Boys Rugby Kit for Michaelmas Term

in addition to the PE kit listed above, boys will need:

- football or rugby boots with velcro fastenings or 'magic laces' (no tie laces)
- *School rugby shirt
- *School long rugby socks

Year Two Hockey Kit for Lent Term

in addition to the PE kit listed above, all Y2 children will need:

- shin pads
- gum shield (moulded)
- hockey stick (hip height)

All articles of clothing must be clearly named, (including underwear and shoes). Name labels are available (to order) from the School Shop.

Additional Notes

Water Bottles

All children should bring a named 'sports style' bottle of water to school each day. The responsibility for washing and refilling is that of the parents.

Hair

Children with long hair should have it tied back and clear of the eyes; all bands, bobbles and ribbons should be in School uniform colours. Short hair must be clear of the eyes.

Jewellery

Jewellery must not be worn in school. Watches must be removed for P.E. lessons.

Earrings:

Children are only allowed to wear studs in school. Parents must provide a roll of tape so that earrings can be covered for P.E. lessons. Ideally, flat backs to earrings are preferred. Hoops are not allowed.

Physical Activities

It would be helpful if your child could keep their PE/Games kit in school all week. (The weather does tend to govern outside activities.)

School Uniform Shop

The School Shop aims to be a one-stop shop and is located in the Sports Hall off Shelburne Road. In addition to the regulation uniform which must be purchased from the Shop, it stocks

the majority of items on the School uniform lists, including a range of footwear, sports equipment, stationery, toiletries and confectionery.
