

Spraying for Insect Information

The Washington State Legislature has developed regulations that require the school district to notify parents at least 48 hours in advance of any applications of pesticides in the district, except when the application is done in an emergency situation to control pests posing an immediate threat to human health or safety. The district requests that any citizen who wishes to be notified of spraying to please make a written request and to include their name and current phone number or email address, and that it be delivered to the district office. Parents who notify the district in writing will be contacted by phone or email by district personnel prior to any sprayings.

The City of South Bend may spray for these infestations on an emergency basis without the ability of notifying the district or public with a 48-hour warning. The spray is applied in an *ultra-low volume, non-thermal aerosol cold fog* allowing maximum control over the places and volumes sprayed. It is specifically designed to be used in residential and recreational areas.

The district is in possession of the Material Safety Data Sheet for this product and will provide a copy to anyone who requests it.
