# **ADMISSIONS CRITERIA**

Renaissance holds central its mission to be the premier medium sized international school in Ho Chi Minh City that supports fully the language and cultural heritage of its Vietnamese students as well as offering an attractive MFL programme to students of other nationalities. We seek to develop true English bilingual proficiency upon graduating.

The school's reputation is for academic rigour and innovation, internationalism, leadership and service, responsibility for self and others, in line with IB objectives. The school places a strong emphasis on sports, performing and creative arts. A positive learning environment built on a robust pastoral system develops healthy relationships, whilst promoting an atmosphere in which students are highly valued as individuals within a close family- focused school community.

For applicants with additional needs, placement decisions are determined following a comparative audit of particular learning challenges and needs with available staffing resourcing at the time of application.

All student applicants undergo CAT4 Tests (Years 2 to 13 only) after which they are required to attend a personal interview with Section Heads and the Head of School.
