BOARD SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR AUDIT - FINANCE COMMITTEE

In accordance with a policy #6690 Adopted on December 9, 2019, the White Plains Board of Education will seek one additional community member to add to its Audit/Finance Committee, to assist in providing financial oversight for the District.

The committee, which also includes three Board of Education members, meets once a month during the school year, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at Education House. Membership will be for the 2023-24 school year.

Individuals who wish to apply should possess knowledge of accounting, auditing, financial reporting and school district finances. Interested individuals should send a letter of interest and resume to the District Clerk, 5 Homeside Lane, 10605. Letters must be received by October 6, 2023, and interviews will be conducted by the current committee members. The Board expects to make the appointment at its Regular Meeting in November.

Education Law stipulates that committee members must be independent, and the following individuals are precluded from being an Audit Committee member:

- Someone currently employed by the District.
- Someone currently or previously providing goods or services to the District during the past two years.
- Someone who is not a member of the Board of Education who has an immediate family member (spouse, spouse equivalent or dependent, whether or not related) or close family member (parent, sibling or nondependent child) who is an employee, officer or contractor providing goods or services to the district.
- Someone who is the owner of or has a direct and material interest in a company providing goods or services to the district.
