Student Expectations for a Positive Learning Environment

ACADEMICS

- All students have the right to an education and the right to learn.
- All students will come to school prepared with the required materials for class: laptop, charger, binder.
- Students will check their student portal accounts on a regular basis and maintain a weekly planner with upcoming assignments, projects, tests/quizzes.
- Students have the opportunity to re-learn classroom material until mastery is achieved.
- Students will connect with their teachers when they are absent from school and make arrangements to make up missed assignments.
- Teachers will differentiate learning to meet the needs of ALL learners.
- Teachers will update grades on a weekly basis.
- Teachers will communicate with families when celebrations and/or struggles arise.

BEHAVIOR

- Students will assist school staff in maintaining a safe school community for all students.
- Students will treat one another with respect and dignity.
- Students will conduct themselves in an appropriate physical and/or verbal manner.
- Students will recognize and respect the rights of others.
- Students will respect and maintain the school's property and the property of others.
- Students are encouraged to reach out to trusted adults when concerns arise.
- Administration and staff are here to teach appropriate behaviors.
- When behavior concerns surface, contact will be made with families and together we will create a success plan.
