Student Expectations for a Positive Learning Environment

As a parent or guardian it is critical that you are familiar with school guidelines so you can support your student for a successful education at John Glenn Middle School. Working together, we can be a strong influence on students by modeling adult working relationships based upon honesty and respect to one another.

Below we have highlighted some of our school guidelines:

AFTER SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

- All students will be out of the hallways and out by the main entrance by 2:15 everyday. The exceptions are if students are being supervised by staff for the following: participating in athletics, working with staff, TOPS classes, or EPIC.
- Students must be supervised by their parent/guardian in order to watch a sporting event.
- Students who are picked up from school must wait at the main entrance.

DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

- Clothing must be suitable for and not distract from all scheduled classroom activities.
- Clothing may not use or depict hate speech targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation or any other protected groups.
- Clothing may not depict, advertise or advocate the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana or other controlled substances.
- Shoes must be worn during the school day.
- Sunglasses will remain in backpacks during the school day.
- Blankets should be kept at home.
- Face coverings will be limited to masks only (covering nose and mouth).
- If these guidelines are not being followed, a student may be asked to make changes before resuming the school day.
