

IMMUNIZATION NOTICE

April 24, 2023

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The New Jersey Department of Health requires all 6th grade students who have turned 11 years old to have the following immunizations:

- 1. Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis Vaccine (Tdap)**
- 2. Meningococcal Vaccine**

The Walter Hill School Health Office must receive proof of immunization for your child. **Bring/send/fax or scan documentation from your doctor to the main office.** The documentation must be stamped, signed and dated by the doctor. Fax: (856) 467-4016.

These immunizations can be administered by the Gloucester County Health Department for families without health insurance. They are located in Sewell and Paulsboro with hours by appointment. Please call them at (856) 218-4127.

If your child is not 11 years old, the immunizations are expected to be scheduled within a one week grace period. Please submit documentation from your doctor of your appointment date.

Proof of immunization or a written appointment date is due by September 8. Students may be excluded from school if they are not immunized.
