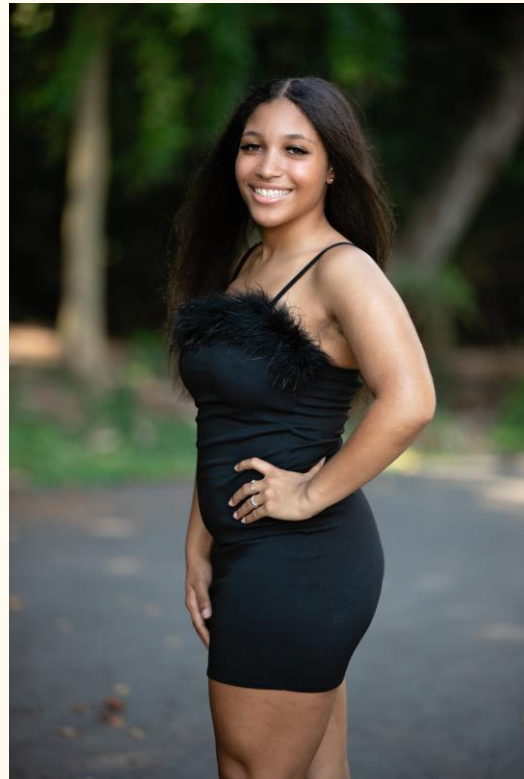
First Friend at Woodland Hills: Brianna Mason
