

Our state standards require students at nearly all grade levels to write across different genres, including narratives, opinions, and persuasive pieces. However, the standards explain how to reach those goals and many teacher preparation programs do not provide research-based instruction in how to teach students to write well. TWR offers a clear, coherent method of instruction for any subject or grade level that turns struggling writers into strong communicators, deepens their understanding of content, and develops their analytical abilities. Colleges and employers value clear and effective writing, but the NAEP found that only about 24% of students in grades 8 and 11 were proficient writers in 2019. Boosting writing skills improves oral communication, analytical skills, and even reading comprehension.

This course will introduce participants to the Hochman Method, an explicit set of sequenced strategies for teaching expository writing that can be integrated into any content area. The strategies are presented to improve the structure, coherence, and clarity of students' writing, beginning at the sentence level. The focus moves to outlines, paragraphs, and compositions. Participants will also learn how to teach note-taking, summarization, and revision. There are opportunities to practice and create activities tailored to your grade level and subject. This course is appropriate for educators in grades 3-12 but is especially suited to teachers (including Special Education and ENL) of English and social studies.



