Acceptable Academic Entry routes to Exempt you From Taking the Workkeys test

Bachelors Degree
ACT score of 22 or higher
ASVAB score of 38 G (minimum qualification for Air Force Firefighter –3E571)

2 and 3 must not be greater than 5 years old

How do I sign up for the Workkeys assessment?

- Contact our front desk at 513.771.8881.
- Must pay for test (\$50) at time of scheduling. A
 credit card will be accepted over the phone.
- Any scheduling changes, contact the front desk (513.771.8881) within 24 hours before scheduled test.



Facts About the Entrance Assessment

- It is taken on the computer at Great Oaks Testing Center. (Entry 8)
- Results are immediate and valid for 5 years.
- Contact Molly Maundrell at <u>maundrellm@greatoaks.com</u> for accommodations paperwork if needed (documentation no more than 3 years old)
 - It takes a minimum of 10 days to process.
- Cost for test is \$50.00 & \$25.00 per test to retake



WorkKeys® testing at Scarlet Oaks Use Entrance 8 (RAMTEC) Day of Testing

- Arrive at least 15 minutes early.
- Bring valid government issued ID (driver's license).
- Testing will take 3.5 4 hours.
