COLLEGE BOUND?

- Take the ACT and/or SAT if necessary (See dates and registration info on pg. 2) Send scores to colleges
- Research & VISIT colleges! You are allowed 2 absences for college visits (with proper documentation)
- Attend NISD College Fair—October 19, 2023 @ 6:30 PM—@ Eaton High School
- Complete college applications—check college websites for deadlines
- Request transcripts (Via CommonApp or via **Parchment** for all non-CommonApp schools)
- Request letters of recommendation via CommonApp or directly from recommender (Counselors have request form on the website)
- Take TSI if needed (see exemptions on pg. 2)
- Complete FAFSA—The redesigned FAFSA is expected to launch in December 2023 for the 2024-25 academic year — a delay from the typical Oct. 1 release date. You can still submit the 2023-24 FAFSA until June 30, 2024
- Apply for scholarships! See counseling website and/or MajorClarity
- Tell us about any scholarships you received using the link on our website (You will need to upload documentation)
- Request final transcripts via Parchment—do this in May when you complete the senior survey
- Send all dual credit transcripts from NCTC, TCC, or UT via those institutions to your chosen college
- Send AP scores to chosen college via collegeboard.org

- Talk to a recruiter (Complete the Military Interest Survey on the Counseling Website to connect with our Military liaison and a recruiter)
- Take the ASVAB—October 6, 2023 (See counseling website, CCMR Planning tab, to sign up)

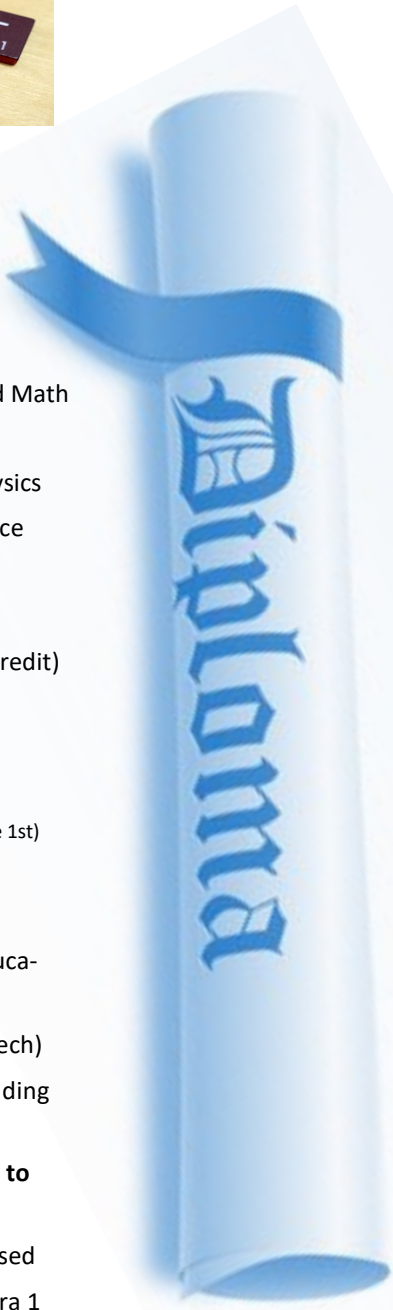
- Foreign Lang. 1 Foreign Lang. 2

You must have at least 26 state credits to graduate.
