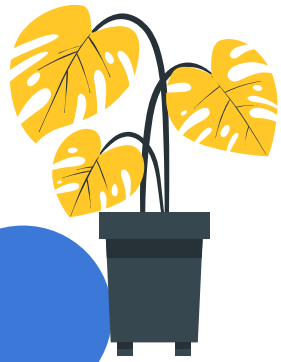

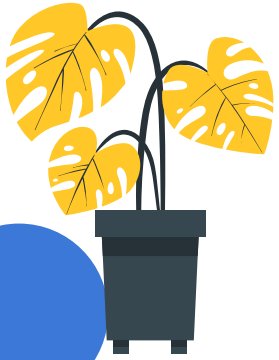
Wilcox Mission and Vision

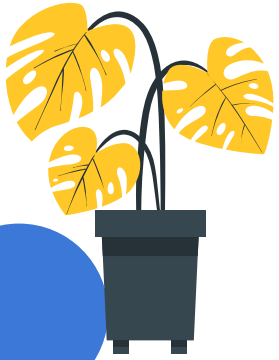
