# Academic Excellence

    - Met with 7<sup>th</sup> grade team
    - Created an “Advisory” for 7<sup>th</sup> graders in the middle school schedule for the 2023-2024 SY
    - 7<sup>th</sup> grade teachers worked on sequencing their skills and curriculum – May SCD
    - Summer Curriculum proposal was approved to develop the curriculum

# Student Experience

- Survey middle and high school students for interests in electives that are not offered yet.
  - Develop a student survey to determine course interest and student needs
  - Additionally, questions will assess the students' sense of climate and culture of the school community.
- Continue the District SEL Committee, examine mental health staffing and utilization, and expand resources.
  - Provide resources to Administrators, Teachers, and Support Staff in Therapeutic Crisis Intervention (TCI) training
  - Provide training in Executive Functioning to the staff to assist all students to be successful
