



## Christian Life Retreat Expectations Form

As our students participate in educational travel, they act as representatives of, and ambassadors for, Christian Heritage School. This underscores the importance of behaving in a Christ-like, respectful manner from every aspect of our being: our speech, our actions, and our dress.

Please read through the following expectations so you may be aware of and will abide by the expectations.

### Specific Rules and Regulations:

1. While representing CHS, both inside and outside of the community, students are required to follow the rules of the Student Handbook. The CHS Administration retains at its sole discretion the prerogative to assign discipline for unmet behavioral expectations.
2. The possession, use, or association with alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, vapes or vape products, or unlawful drugs is forbidden.
3. Electronics are not permitted on the retreat.
4. Behavior that would interfere with the rights of others, (particularly other guests), or that would reflect poorly upon CHS will not be tolerated. This type of behavior includes but is not limited to disrespect, profanity, boisterousness, or PDA.
5. The dress code is clean, modest, casual clothing everywhere. Never go out of bunk rooms unless you are dressed in appropriate attire.
6. Immediately report any illness or injury to the nurse. The nurse must know about all medications.
7. Students will be prompt for all itinerary events.
8. All rooms, bags, and belongings are subject to inspection by the staff person in charge.
9. Students must adhere to curfews. They are for the students' protection and are necessary for the welfare and reputation of the organization. Curfews will be set each day. Anyone late for curfew will face disciplinary action. You must not leave your room after curfew until the next morning.
10. Bunkhouses are bedrooms. Under no circumstances should students of the opposite gender be in the bunkhouse of the opposite gender.
11. All students assigned to a room will be held jointly accountable for any damage or missing items. Check the condition of your room upon arrival and report any problems to an adult.
