

# Tabletop Gaming Club (TTGC)

Welcome to the 2022/23 Tabletop Gaming Club! Our goal is to connect with friends (or make new friends) while playing non-digital games. There is something special about rolling dice, shuffling cards, and moving tokens around a board. The types of games that we play include:

- Dungeons & Dragons (or other tabletop role-playing games)
- Magic: the Gathering (or other collectable card games like Pokemon or Yu-Gi-Oh)
- Party Games (like One Night Ultimate Werewolf)
- Board games (like checkers or Settlers of Catan)

All content in TTGC will be a PG-rating but may contain “fantasy” content such as knights sword-fighting, wizards casting magic spells, and monsters challenging the players.

Mr. Murphy will have some games available for students to play, but students are encouraged to bring their own games (or Magic: the Gathering cards!).

We will meet on **Wednesdays after school from 4:00pm-5:00pm** in the PJHW Library, except when the library is in use for events like Book Fairs, in which case we will meet in Room 500 or the Cafeteria. Any changes to our schedule or location will be announced during school announcements during 3<sup>rd</sup> period.

## Expectations

TTGC members must abide by all school rules and expectations, which can be summarized by our policy of “*Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful*”.

*Be Safe:* no running or physical play (rough housing) in TTGC

*Be Responsible:* show up on time, leave on time, put away games when finished

*Be Respectful:* use appropriate language, encourage instead of criticizing, resolve conflicts calmly, and be careful with game materials

Student **MUST** have transportation arranged **before** they come to a TTGC meeting! At 4:55pm, Mr. Murphy will escort students out of the library and to the front of the school to be picked up by a parent. Once students leave the front door at 5pm, Mr. Murphy and PJHW will no longer be supervising students – so, parents, please arrive promptly.

We will have a lot of fun in TTGC and the memories that students make around the table can be the foundation for lifelong friendships!
