The Cherokee County School District has announced that 10/11/23 will be an early release day for those taking the PSAT or SAT. Check our website for an Early Release Permission Slip which needs to be returned to your student's **FIRST PERIOD TEACHER** by 10/6/23. We will follow a procedure similar to Early Release Day's during Exam Week, but we do ask for your patience with the dismissal time since we must follow College Board testing protocols. Locations for student pick-up are designated on the attached map.

Creekview High School will be administering the PSAT 8/9 to all 9th grade students and the PSAT/NMSQT test to 10th grade students on Wednesday, October 11, 2023. **NO REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED**, students are automatically assigned to test for free. This exam date is scheduled by the College Board and this is a national testing date.

11th grade students wishing to take the PSAT/NMSQT to be considered for National Merit Scholarship competition, must be registered for the exam.

12th grade students wishing to take the SAT School Day test must be registered for the exam.

Participation in the PSAT provides many benefits to students including: potential identification for gifted services or advanced/AP coursework; personalized SAT practice specific to individual student needs through Khan Academy; District recognition through the Superintendent's Key Scholars program; potential identification for college scholarships; and providing additional information for teachers to improve instruction while preparing students for College and Career opportunities after High School.

All students who **are** participating in testing on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, will be expected to report to school at regular time, **no later than 8:30am**. Details regarding testing room assignments will be communicated to students through homeroom.

Please be advised that for students who submit early release forms we will not dismiss students individually. Dismissal will take place once the test administration for the school is complete. We want to ensure a quiet and distraction-free environment for all test takers. Please be advised that our dismissal may be delayed due to testing procedures and required test administration times. We anticipate dismissal time to be between 12:30 and 12:45 if there are no issues.

11th and 12th grade students who are not testing should not report to school.

For juniors and seniors not attending school, teachers will post remediation and recovery assignments in Canvas by 8 am on 10/11. All teachers will be either proctoring exams or in a supervisory role during the day. They will not be able to respond to e-mails immediately.

Students who remain on campus after testing will have remediation and recovery assignments. Those assignments will also be available in Canvas for students who leave campus.

As a reminder, October 9th is a Teacher Workday and a student holiday. Students do not attend school that day.
