Signing In & Out

Students who are enrolled in Community School will be dismissed directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the class begins. Any student who does not get picked up after their class has been over for 10 minutes, will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily after care rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's account.
