The Livingston High Boys' Cross-Country team had a great week! The boys' team comes into the Fall 2023 season with high expectations; high expectations come from having four returning runners from the 2022 team that qualified for the California State Championship Cross Country meet in Fresno. This past week the boys placed first in the kickoff meet of the Trans Valley League (TVL). The team scored 61, ahead of second-place teams Escalon and Ripon who had matching scores of 67. They then went on the road to Folsom on Saturday (9/9) and finished in the top 10 in a field of over 40 schools. Within that finish, the Pack was the highest-finishing D4 school in the field.
