Sample Parent Letter

The District would like to offer your child access to our educational computer network. Upon you and your child signing the enclosed Student Agreement, your child will have access to various software applications, hundreds of databases, libraries, and computer services from all over the world through the Internet and other electronic information systems.

With this educational opportunity also comes responsibility. It is important that you and your child read the enclosed District policy, regulation, and agreement form, and discuss these requirements together. Inappropriate network use will result in the loss of the privilege to use the District's educational computer network.

The Internet is a system which links smaller networks creating a large and diverse network. The Internet allows your child the opportunity to reach out to many other people to share information, learn concepts, and research subjects, by the sending and receiving of messages using a computer, and wired and wireless internet access points.

In spite of our efforts to establish regulations for the use of the District's computer network, please be aware that there may be material or communications on the Internet or other networks that District staff, parents, and students would find objectionable. We cannot filter items posted on connected computers and devices by others.
