Transportation



- Families are encouraged to provide transportation to/from 4K whenever possible
- Bus transportation is provided for morning sessions within your residence zone
- Students at 4K sites *in* Oregon ride bus to the Prairie View Elementary and Netherwood Knoll Elementary bus loop and board a shuttle that transports to 4K sites
- Students in Brooklyn Elementary attendance area are transported to Brooklyn Elementary school and board a shuttle that transports to to Heart of Brooklyn
- Students in Forest Edge attendance area are <u>Constitutes</u> <u>Building</u> transported directly to Mariposa



Attendance Guidelines



Children are eligible for 4K if they are...

- Residents of the Oregon School District
- Age 4 on or before September 1, 2023
- Age 5 and have not attended 4K
- Planning on attending Kindergarten in 2024-2025
 Notes
 - There are no early admissions
 - 4K is designed to be a one-year program
 - There are limited number of open-enrollment spaces for children who reside in another district that offers 4K

Open Enrollment

Feb 6 - Apr 28

- Families must complete online application through WI Dept of Instruction (DPI) <u>http://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment</u>
- Student's resident district must offer a 4K program
- Must be accepted as an open-enrolled student in the Oregon School District prior to being enrolled in 4K
- OE Notice of Approval/Denial Letters: June 9, 2023
