Non-Resident Tuition Student Acknowledgement of Terms and Conditions

Upon completion of the required documentation to register a non-resident student and with recommendation of the Superintendent and Board approval in the Manheim Central School District, I/we also acknowledge and understand the following:

1. The Manheim Central School District honors the decisions of other school entities and their boards of directors. Therefore, the District will not accept non-resident students on a tuition basis, paid for by parents/guardians, if the student was previously suspended or presently is suspended or expelled from any public or private school of this Commonwealth or any other state for an act or offense involving weapons, alcohol, or drugs; for the willful infliction of injury to another person; for any act of violence committed on school property, or under the provisions of Pennsylvania School Code 24 P.S. § 13-1318.1, Students Convicted or Adjudicated Delinquent of Sexual Assault.
2. The Manheim Central School District will only accept students who require a free appropriate public education (FAPE) through an individualized education program (IEP), if it can provide FAPE with its current set of resources in place, at the time of admission.
3. Any failure to pay a monthly tuition bill in a timely fashion may be cause to unenroll the student from the Manheim Central School District.
4. Transportation to and from the school, regardless of the schedule, will not be provided by the Manheim Central School District.
5. Student athletes and their parents/guardians should consider potential PIAA implications for a transfer from one school entity to another. PIAA student athletes who transfer to different school entities may face changes in their eligibility to compete in interscholastic sports under PIAA's rules, depending on the circumstances. As a broad rule, the PIAA requires that any student who transfers after playing a sport in their 10th grade year shall not be eligible to participate in the ensuing PIAA tournament in that sport. If otherwise eligible, the student may participate in that sport only during the regular season. Therefore, prior to enrolling in the District on a nonresident tuition basis, please consider the impact of such a transfer and contact PIAA for more details.
