School Funding

- May provide additional funding for state and federal programs and services at our schools.
 - A couple programs that may be affected are all-day kindergarten and the Fruit and Veggie Snack Program grant.
- Internet Access
- May qualify your family for discounted rates on home internet services.

Academic Perks

- May qualify you for reduced registration fees for AP, SAT, and/or ACT tests. May also qualify you for discounted rates associated with college admissions.
- Every eligible form counts and adds valuable resources to our schools.

It's Easy to Apply

- It's easy! Completing an application takes less than 10 minutes and you only need to complete **one application per family**.

- Complete an application online in the Infinite Campus portal or you may pick up a paper copy at your school. Contact your school secretary if you don't have access to the Parent Portal in Infinite Campus.
- Applications are completely confidential and will not be shared. Since your family's financial situation may change from year to year, you must fill out a new application each school year.

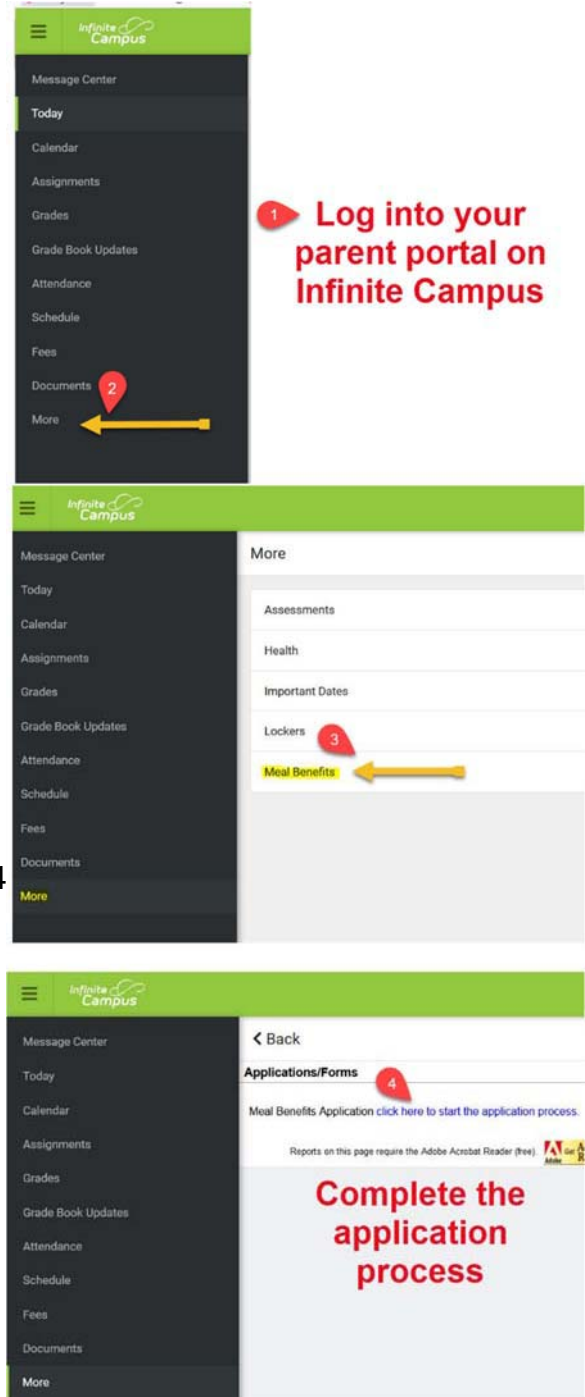
