

Stow-Munroe Falls School Board Student Representative Roles and Responsibilities

Goals:

1. Liaison between all students and the School Board and between the School Board to students.
2. Represent student interests (student voice) on policy and procedures.
3. Be a voice to the Board regarding student issues, questions, concerns and successes.
4. Provide communication between the School Board and the student body.

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Attend training meetings with Superintendent and/or Mentor Board Member.
2. Be present at all regularly scheduled work session (usually second Monday monthly) school board meetings, and as many other regularly scheduled meetings as possible. The student representative will have a seat at the table with school leadership and Board members but will not be a voting member of the Board, nor will they participate in Executive Session.
3. Prepare, review with Mentor Board Member, and deliver (with a frequency to be determined through consultation with Mentor Board Member) reports to the Board during meetings, regarding items of student concern and/or student successes.
4. Report out to fellow students any major updates (including policy) from the Board in a variety of ways, including but not limited to:
 - a. At student leadership meetings
 - b. Through the Stohioan
5. Sit in on student board representative interviews and advertise for open position in spring through posting announcements, recruiting from a variety of student groups, visiting classrooms, etc.
