

McKinney Vento/Homeless

Homeless Students

The U.S. McKinney-Vento Assistance Act defines a homeless child as any student that does not have a fixed, regular and adequate place to sleep at night and qualifies for educational assistance. This includes students and families that stay at a shelter, motel/hotel, car, park, abandoned apartment/building, or with relatives or others due to lack of housing.

Student Rights

The Education for Homeless Children and Youth program, as part of the McKinney-Vento, indicates student rights of the following:

- Choice of school: Children eligible for McKinney-Vento services may attend their school of origin (school last attended or school attended when a child lost permanent housing) or attend the school that serves their temporary living situation (choice of caregiver)
- Immediate enrollment: Even if medical or other records, birth certificates, or transcripts cannot be produced at the time of enrollment
- Transportation: Must be provided if requested
- Preschool: Priority consideration to preschool programs for eligible youngsters

- Free lunch and fee waivers: Categorically eligible for free lunch
- Supplemental tutoring: If needed

Dispute Process

Calumet City School District 155 dispute resolution process is the last resort used to bridge disagreements between a school district and a student/family. Prior to initiating dispute resolution, the district's local homeless liaison shall attempt to resolve the disagreement informally.

The dispute resolution process contained herein is:

- 1. The only process to formally determine the outcome of a homeless-related dispute between an eligible student and a district
- 2. A method of sensitivity resolving disagreements with respect to eligibility
- 3. To be used for resolving disputes regarding enrollment, full participation in school activities, transportation and other issues related to homelessness.
- 4. To be structured as informally as possible in order to allow parents/guardians or unaccompanied youth as much assistance as possible navigating the process.
