If you are interested in TVS Music lessons and programs (e.g. Orchestra, piano, etc.), please contact Grace Moreno at morenog@tvs.org. TVS Music does not fall under the Auxiliary Programs umbrella – due to their significant work during the school day – although certain TVS Music operations happen after school.

- After-school Orchestra practices are only open to students taking individual TVS Music strings lessons.
- Orchestra practices will occur in the Great Hall Foyer at 3:45-4:45, and dismissal will be at the Great Hall Circle (so as not to conflict with Auxiliary Program dismissal at the Lower School Circle).
- From 3:30-3:45, participants are expected to come to the TVS Dining Hall for a snack (provided). There will be a designated instrument storage space during this 15-minute period. Students should not play or tune their instruments in the TVS Dining Hall.
- Students are encouraged to come to
 Orchestra practice at least once per week, but
 can attend more frequently, if desired. There
 will be a "loose RSVP form" provided by TVS
 Music staff. Whereas there is much flexibility
 in these Orchestra practices, it is good for our
 planning to see approximate daily attendance
 numbers.

Our Enrichment programs are carefully designed experiences that aim to expand and enrich students' academic, creative, and athletic horizons. As such, we request that families register in a timely fashion (prior to the start of each program), so that each child gets the best experience possible! Our instructors have much to offer!

- ALL PROGRAMS begin after Labor Day.
 - Please pay special attention to the specific dates of the programs. Some programs do not begin until the week of October 16.
 - If you see an expected date "missing," this indicates either a no-school day OR a day the instructor is unavailable.
 - Trinity Valley School is not responsible for weather-related cancellations. Whereas we certainly try to
 minimize these last-minute cancellations, we appreciate your understanding if / when they occur! We
 will notify registered families of any such cancellations via email and on our Enrichment website.
- Registration for programs will occur online, via the <u>Auxiliary Programs registration platform</u>, powered by CampBrain. Registration opens on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>July 12</u>, <u>2023</u>, <u>at 5:00 p.m.</u> All participants – both from Trinity Valley School and the community – must register online.
- Several programs have an enrollment cap.
 - When a program fills, CampBrain will automatically switch the program status to "waitlisting." You are welcome to add your child's name to the waitlist, or find other programs that are still open.
 - o If space opens in a waitlisted program, a member of the Auxiliary Programs team will contact you as soon as possible to inquire about finalizing enrollment.
- A 15-minute supervised break for restroom, water, and snack (provided) will occur in the TVS Dining Hall between school-day dismissal and the start of Enrichment programs.
