



Application ask for help as needed

Searching for college list, type of application, making sure it is the

right fit.

### The College List

### My college List--Doubtful

2 Colleges Max 0 – 35% acceptance rate

Colleges I would like to attend that have a low acceptance percentage rate

If you heard that there was a 5% chance of rain today would you bring and umbrella with you?

### The College List

#### Possibilities

5-6 Colleges 36% - 70% acceptance rate

A possible chance of being accepted. 85% of all students attend Colleges in this range



#### Likely

2-3 College Max 71% - 99% acceptance rate

It is very likely you would get into a college in the range

## Find a Good College "Fit" Academically

Testing the water, how cold is it? How deep is it?

The water is safe however I am not ready to jump right in.

Just as you might study a body of water to figure out its temperature, depth and current before venturing in, you need to investigate the rigor, pace and depth of an academic environment -and your ability to keep you "head above water" if admitted -before deciding to apply

Doesn't matter how deep I am confident I can jump right in and succeed.

### **Common Pitfalls**

- **Procrastination**: Senior don't wait till the last minute
- Be aware of all your due dates
- Send Test Scores: What does test optional mean?
  - Don't send score unless you think it is an accurate measure of your ability
- Narrow down your college list
  - The best college for you is the one that fits you as a person
- Make an e-mail just for you colleges
  - This should be professional
- Don't believe everything you hear, if you don't know ask a Counselor

- $\Box$  CSU = Grades (Transcript)
- $\Box$   $\overline{UC}$  = Grades (Transcript) + Personal Statement
- □ Common App = Grades (Transcript) + Test Scores (SAT or ACT) + Personal Statement + Letters of Recommendation

### **California State University**

- California State University (CSU)
- 23 campuses in the state
  - Humboldt in the North
  - San Diego in the South
  - Local SJSU, SFSU, CSUMB, East Bay
- Large campuses for the most part
  - SJSU Freshman Class 3,754
  - Sonoma State Freshman Class 1,740

- Deadlines: Oct 1<sup>st</sup> to Nov. 30
- Apply Early: Before Thanksgiving
- Cost: \$70.00 per campus
- Transcript: Sent through Parchment .com
- College Board Code: 3594


### **CSU Overview**

- 23 Campuses from Humboldt to San Diego
  - Total Tuition & Campus Fees \$7,582
  - Room and Board \$11,662
  - Total Cost of Attendance \$23,312

- Cost will vary slightly based on campus
- Primarily Commuter schools (exceptions)
- Large campus
- Large classes

### **University Of California**

- 9 campuses in the state Davis to San Diego
  - Total Tuition & Campus Fees \$15,352
  - Room and Board \$16,500
  - Total Cost of Attendance \$36,700

- Cost will vary slightly based on campus
- Primarily Residential schools
- Large campus
- Large classes


### **UC** overview continued

- Tuition \$13,000 \$15,000
- Room and Board varies by location
  - \$15,129 to \$16,454
- Financial Aid
  - Berkeley 89% of need met (60% grant 20% loan)
  - UCSC 87% of need met (70% grant 30% loan)




### **Transcripts**


- Check due dates for the college you finally decide to attend and make sure you send your transcript.
- Some colleges out of state will require you to send your transcript instead of self reporting your grades
- Some of the CSU's and UC's might request a mid-year transcript (as part of an audit)
- Once you apply check your portals often





### **Private Schools**

- □ Tuition –Varies
  - Harvard \$46,340 , (R&B) \$17,160
  - CalTech \$50,487, (R&B) \$15,525
  - Harvard 100% of need met (93% grant 7%loan work study) (Average award \$48,876)
  - Caltech 100% of need met (88% grant 12%loan work study) (Average award \$41,990)
- Financial Aid: Is need based
  - Merit Aid: Is based on GPA and/or Test Score
  - Use the Net Price Calculator
- CSS Profile: Through College Board




### Example of institutional aid
